

L.A. TOURISM FACTS AND FIGURES

Record-breaking 2017

- 2017 is the seventh consecutive year that Los Angeles has set tourism milestones
- Los Angeles county welcomed **48.3 MILLION** visitors, a **2.2%** YOY increase
- A record **41.2 MILLION** domestic visitors, a **2.5%** YOY increase
- A record 7.1 MILLION international visitors, a 0.9% YOY increase
- International visitation to Los Angeles surpassed a previous projected forecast, which called for a 0.2% YOY growth

Economic Impact and Jobs:

- In 2016, visitors directly spent \$21.9 BILLION in the local economy, a record. Visitor spend for 2017 will be announced in May
- The economic impact countywide of this direct spend is **\$33.6 BILLION**
- Tourism supports an average of 517,000 jobs within L.A. County's Leisure & Hospitality sector
- Estimates show visitors are expected to generate at least **\$300 MILLION** dollars in transient occupancy tax collections for the City of Los Angeles in 2017, a record
- Since 2012, visitors have generated a 76% increase in TOT collections for the City's general fund

LAX Airport:

• LAX welcomed more than **84.9 MILLION** passengers in 2017, a record
